Horizons Bible Study huge success at SFTS

San Anselmo, Calif., Oct. 2 – The annual Horizons Bible Study sponsored by the San Francisco Theological Seminary Auxiliary was an overwhelming success this year with 240 people attending the Sept. 13 event.

Rev. Dr. Dale Lindsey Morgan presented the study, “Jubilee! Luke’s Gospel for the Poor” in which she explored the many ways that Christ’s jubilee message turned the world upside down, exalting the outsiders and the poor while bringing the love of God to all.

Dale, a former trustee at SFTS, earned her master of divinity and doctor of ministry degrees from the Claremont School of Theology. She served as pastor of congregations in Claremont and Santa Barbara for more than 30 years and has been an elected member of the General Assembly Council of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

Catherine White, president of the SFTS Auxiliary, noted that the attendance and response was “over the top” and the group is already looking forward to next year.

“The Horizons Bible Study this year was fabulous!” White said. “I continue to get compliments about the day. As people were leaving the Seminary, they were already talking about the Bible study for next year. We will definitely try to top this one!”
