Rambo to be interim director of APS program

San Anselmo, Calif., Jan. 20 – Dr. Lewis Rambo, Tulley Professor of Psychology and Religion at San Francisco Theological Seminary, will be the interim director of the Advanced Pastoral Studies program.

Rambo began this new position Jan. 1, following the December retirement of Dr. Warren Lee.

Rambo, one of the senior-most members of the SFTS faculty, has had a long-standing commitment to teaching in the APS program, which administers SFTS' D.Min. degree.

This new role will allow Rambo to focus on this passion and on leading the program through its next 18 months. Pat Perry will continue as program manager.

Rambo will remain on the faculty and teach a course in pastoral psychology occasionally, but he will apply much of his scholarly work and creative energy to reviewing the doctor of ministry program and planning for its future.
