SFTS professor publishes book on controversial Chinese Christian leader

San Anselmo, Calif., Feb. 11 – Philip Wickeri, Hewlett professor of evangelism and mission, recently published his book, “Reconstructing Christianity in China – K.H. Ting and the Chinese Church” (Orbis Books.)

This monumental work recounts a large part of modern Chinese Christian history by telling the story of one of its key protagonists—Bishop K. H. Ting, a public figure both revered and reviled—as he negotiated the path of millions of Chinese Protestant Christians from the triumph of Mao’s Revolution until today.

Wickeri offers a unique perspective on what that survival entailed, not just for Bishop Ting, but for a Christian movement that is today mushrooming beyond anything either Mao Zedong or K. H. Ting could ever have imagined.
